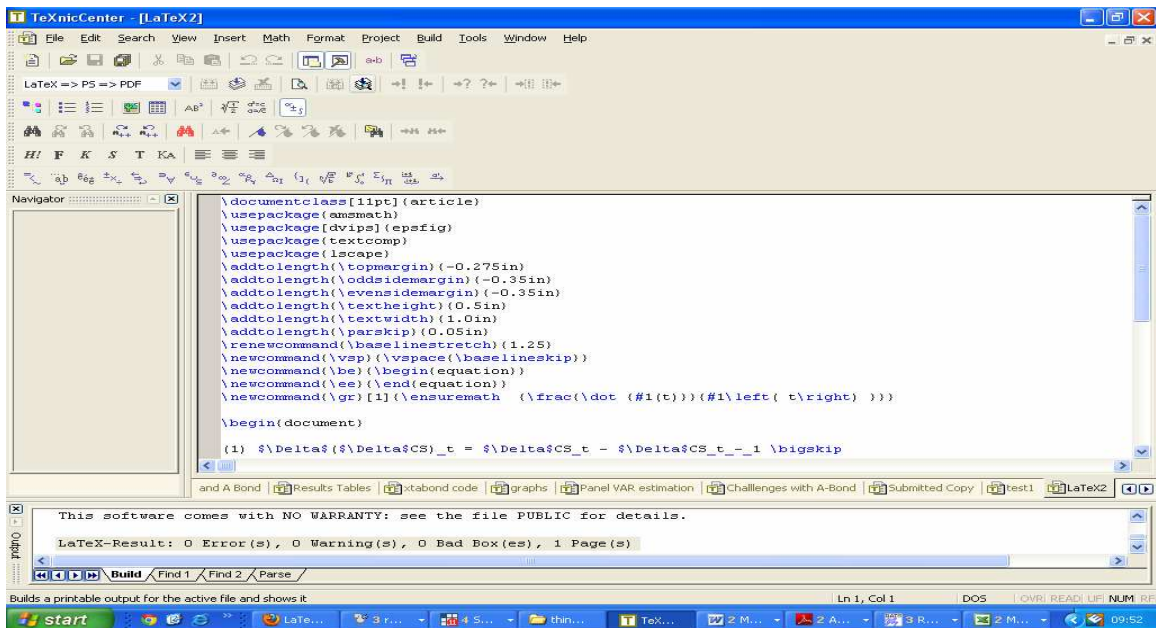
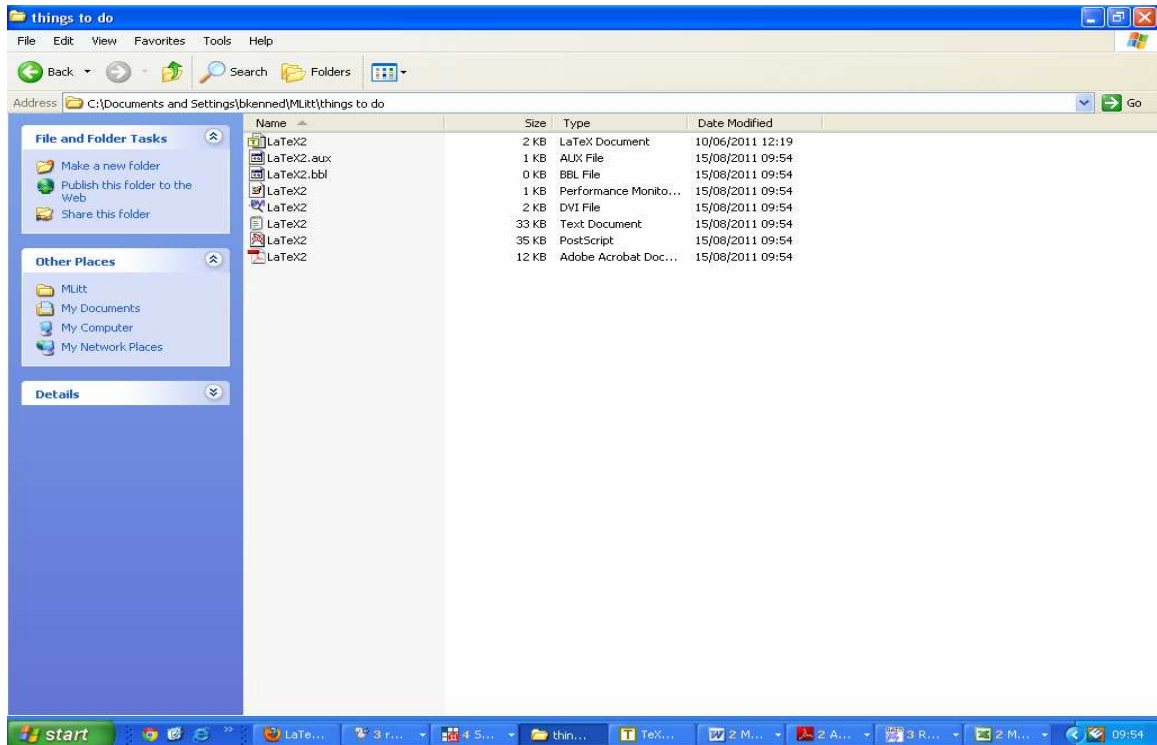


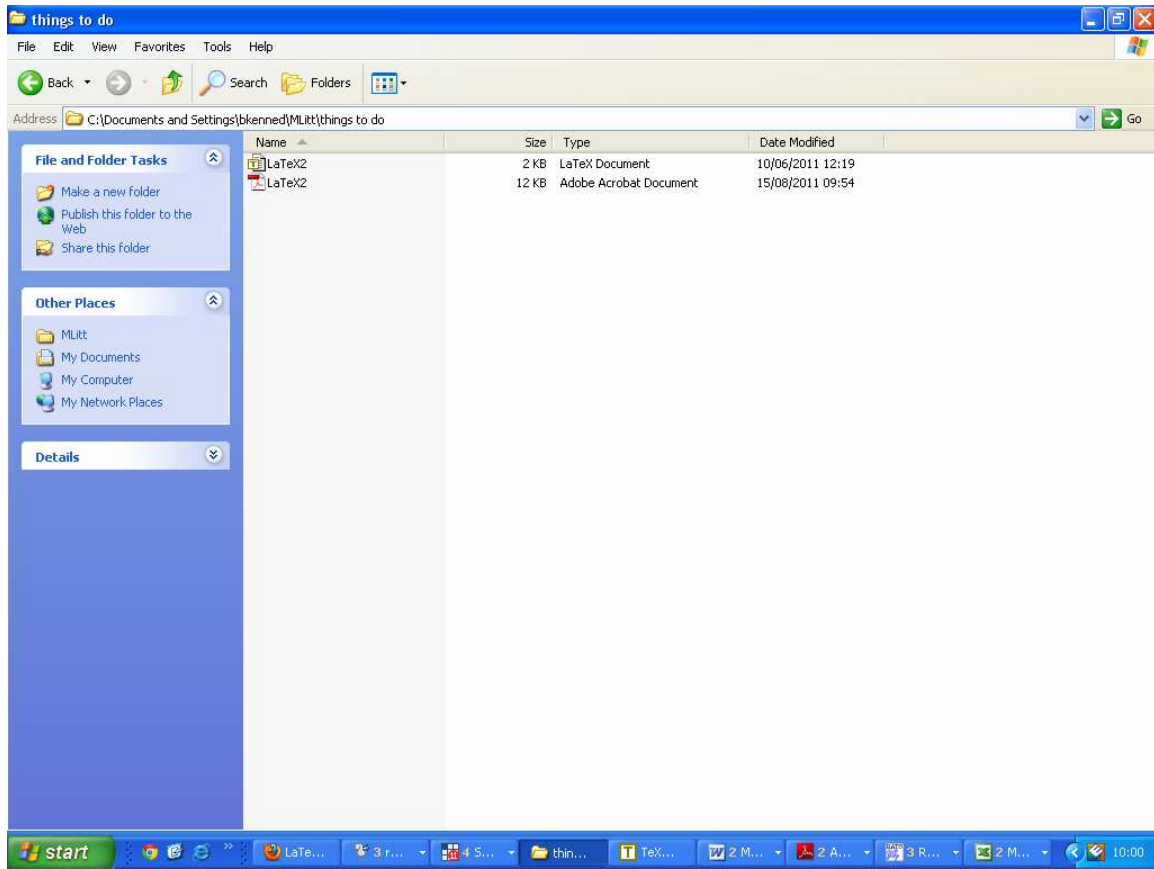
Step 1: I have a tex file called Latex2 saved in the folder “things to do”



Step 2: I open the file and select the shortcut “Build and View”



Step 3: After selecting the option “Build and View” the PDF file appears in the same folder “things to do”, that the underlying tex file is saved to. However, in addition to the tex and PDF files 6 additional files appear: Latex 2.aux, Latex2.bbl, Latex2 – performance monitor file, Latex2 – DVI file, Latex 2 – Text Document, Latex 2 – postscript.



Step 4: It would be preferable, if the only file that appeared in the folder “things to do” after selecting “Build and View” was the PDF file as this is the only file I am directly interested in. Here I am after deleting the following files Latex 2.aux, Latex2.bbl, Latex2 – performance monitor file, Latex2 – DVI file, Latex 2 – Text Document, Latex 2 – postscript and these files can be accessed again by going back into the tex file and selecting “Build and View” again. When you have a lot of tex files in the one folder, all these additional file can make a folder that bit more difficult to manage and create clutter.
